- Tucson Coin Show has the right to close any seller's space without liability of any kind.
- Exhibitor spaces are not transferable.
- **Cancellation Policy:** A cancellation within 75 days of the show will result in a \$100 forfeiture of fees, and a cancellation within 40 days of the show will result in a \$200 forfeiture of fees. All cancellations should be directly given to the show chairman (Ben 520-331-8714).
- The Bourse fee includes 6-foot tables and electrical, plus badges for the show, two chairs for customers, and two chairs for exhibitors. The fee also includes a Pascua Yaqui "Short Term" license. Security is provided throughout the show, starting half an hour before set up and ending half an hour after scheduled closing time.
- By signing, you acknowledge security may try to stop crime, maintain order, and prevent criminal acts that are visible to him/her. There can be no assurance that the security personnel can stop crime. Exhibitors and their agents agree to be solely responsible for any theft, damage, or disappearance of their merchandise and will insure said merchandise. Exhibitor guarantees to hold harmless the Tucson Coin Show, its officers and agents, the Casino del Sol, and their officers and agents from any claim resulting from their participation in this show.
- Tucson Coin Show officers and representatives will not be held responsible for exhibitors' losses due to theft, fire, flood, earthquake, weather, panic, riots, civil unrest, strikes, disease, or any other condition that prevents the show from opening, continuing through the scheduled dates, or opening on time.

We believe a coin show should represent all levels of education and budget throughout a person's coin-collecting journey. Coin dealers are ambassadors for the hobby and have a fiduciary trust in their clientele. Our goal is to have the friendliest coin show.

The world of coin collecting is changing rapidly. A lot of that has to do with how information is distributed and consumed. As dealers, we need to collectively learn that some of our old ways will not create the same results as in the past. We need to move to where the collector is. A part of this is ensuring we have solid regional events and encourage new collectors to come to shows, learn, and see what the market offers.

The world between dealers and collectors has never been so blurred as today, with collectors having easy access to other collectors. As dealers, we must abandon the “zero-sum game” attitude and embrace the “rising tide lifts all boats” mentality. For any dealers setting up at the show, I'll do a short Zoom call video with you that we can edit and put on our website and social media so customers get to know you ahead of time and are more willing to come to your booth and do business with you because you are no longer a stranger. If you would like to promote another coin show, just bring their flyers. I will have a table to promote shows. I will also have a table for coin clubs to promote their clubs.

Our goal is for everyone at the show to have both a successful and enjoyable experience. Early Bird badges are available for a show set-up day. We also have dealer badges for early entry on set-up days and early and late exits on show days. Please do not get a dealer badge for a friend to work the setup day but not at your table.. If the dealer doesn't think it's worth \$50-\$75 to come and do business, then I'm not doing my job as a show promoter, and they should find a worthwhile show to participate in.
